- _____ 1. **BEFORE BURNING** call the Los Fresnos Volunteer Fire Department (LFVFD): **956-233-4473**.
- _____ 2. **The owner is responsible for determining when a burn ban is in effect via the LFVFD. This permit is suspended during burn bans. You must present this burn permit when asked by officials.**
- _____ 3. Burn only plant waste: tree cuttings, brush, grass, leaves, branch trimmings or similar. No domestic waste may be burned including, but not limited to: paper, letters, newspapers, kitchen garbage, cardboard, packaging of any kind, clothing, tires, non-wood construction debris, furniture, carpet, electrical wire and appliances.
- _____ 4. Burning may occur only on the property where the waste was generated.
- _____ 5. Burning must be undertaken by the property owner or owner’s agent. Those leasing property for residential, commercial or agricultural use have the same rights and responsibilities as the property owner for outdoor burning. The property owner is fully responsible for the burn and for compliance with all requirements.
- _____ 6. Do not burn closer than 300 ft. to neighboring residences or occupied structures without permission.
- _____ 7. The burn site must be clear of brush, trees, dry grass and other combustible materials.
- _____ 8. Burn only between sunrise and one hour before sunset.
- _____ 9. Burn piles may be no more than 4 feet high and 10 feet across.
- _____ 10. A responsible adult must 1) have immediate access to telephone services 2) tend the fire at all times and 3) have the necessary provisions to extinguish or manage fires.
- _____ 11. Wind speed must be between 2 and 20 mph so that smoke is rapidly dissipated and ash and embers are not carried beyond the limits of the property.
- _____ 12. Fires must be immediately extinguished if there is a negative impact on neighbors.
- _____ 13. I have received a copy of the Town of Bayview Outdoor Burning Ordinance 2015-09-10.

FAILURE TO TELEPHONE THE FIRE DEPARTMENT BEFORE BURNING or failure to comply with the terms of this permit or Bayview’s ORDINANCE 2011-07-21, or burning without a permit, may result in: 1) the revocation of the Annual Burn Permit 2) up to a \$500 fine and \$250 Administrative Costs imposed by the Bayview Building and Standards Commission. Separate from the Town of Bayview, additional State, County and Local fines and fees may be assessed.
