## ORDER FOR TOWN OFFICER ELECTION

THE STATE OF TEXAS )  
COUNTY OF CAMERON )

WHEREAS, pursuant to an order entered herein on October 17, 1959, an election was held for the purpose of voting on the question of incorporation of the town of BAYVIEW, TEXAS; and

WHEREAS, the voters of said election voted in favor of incorporating said town and a canvass of the votes cast in said election has been completed, the undersigned County Judge of Cameron County, has entered upon the records of the Commissioners Court that the inhabitants of the town of BAYVIEW are incorporated within the boundaries thereof and it is now proper that an election be held for the purpose of electing officers for said town.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the undersigned, County Judge of Cameron County, that an election be held in said town of BAYVIEW on the 14th day of December, 1959, for the purpose of electing a Mayor, a Marshal and five (5) Aldermen.

Said election shall be held at the office of the Cameron County Water Improvement District No. 11 in Bayview, Cameron County, Texas, and the following named persons are hereby appointed officers of said election, to-wit:

The ballots of said election shall have written or printed thereon the words "Official Ballot" and the names of the candidates and the office for which they are a candidate.

Each voter shall mark out with black ink or black pencil all the candidates for whom he does not wish to vote, thus leaving the other or others as indicating his vote.

The manner of holding said election shall be governed, as near as may be, by the General Election laws of the State of Texas, except as modified by the provisions of Chapter 2, Title 28, Vernon's Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas, Revision of 1925, as amended, and none but resident qualified voters of said City shall be allowed to vote at said election.

Notice of the election called by this order shall be given by the publication of notice of election, incorporating this order therein in full, one (1) time immediately hereafter, in the San Benito News, and by posting notice of such election in the following three (3) public places in said town:

- (1) The office of Cameron County Water Improvement District No. 11, Bayview, Cameron County, Texas;
- (2) The Bayview Garage, Bay-

view, Cameron County, Texas;

- (3) The Bayview Grocery, Bayview, Cameron County, Texas.
- which notices shall also incorporate this order in full.

The Presiding Judge is hereby

authorized and directed to cause said notice to be given as hereinabove directed and further orders are reserved until the returns of said election are made by the duly authorized election officials and

received by this Court.
