TOWN OF BAYVIEW Minutes – Board of Aldermen May 24, 2012

- The Board of Aldermen of the Town of Bayview met in a Regular Meeting on Thursday, May 24, 2012 at 6:00 p.m. in the Girl Scout West Building, 102 South San Roman Road, Bayview. Present were: Mayor Leon Deason, Aldermen Ed Morris, Mark Mullendore, Garry Lowder and Jim Stewart. Also present were Building Inspector Donny Curry and Town Secretary Carol DeMoss. - 2. Mayor Deason led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3. Under the Texas Open Meetings Law, Chapter 551, and Title Five (5) under the Texas Local Government Code, a closed executive session convened to discuss:
 - a. Personnel
 - b. Legal Proceeding

The executive session adjourned and the open meeting was called to order at 6:40 p.m.

4. Public comments were invited by Mayor Deason. There were none.

Action Items:

- 5. Consent Agenda Items: Upon a motion made by James Stewart and seconded by Garry Lowder minutes of the May 17, 2012 Regular Board meeting were unanimously approved.
- 6. Mayor Deason stated that there were no motions made on anything arising from the Executive Session.
- A motion was made by Garry Lowder to decline the contract from LRGVDC/TCEQ for the \$30,000 chipper project based on the all of the information, and objections discussed. Mark Mullendore seconded. All approved.
- 8. Mayor Deason reported on various possible bank loans stating that the interest rate will depend upon the funding being approved as tax free by the Attorney General. He then read a letter of opinion from David Irwin, Town attorney, who suggested that the Town of Bayview begin a process with First Community Bank of Los Fresnos. A motion was made by James Stewart to accept the offer made by First Community Bank of \$400,000 at the rate of 5.45%. It was seconded by Ed Morris. All approved.
- Mark Mullendore motioned with James Stewart seconding to approve billing from Girl Scouts of Greater South Texas for \$1209.54 at an average cost of 201.54 per month and covering the period of July 1, 2011 – December, 2011. All approved.
- 10. James Stewart motioned to adjourn the meeting at 7:10 p.m. It was seconded by Ed Morris. All approved.
