# Notice is Hereby given that the, Board of Aldermen, of The Town of Bayview, Texas Pursuant to Chapter 551 of the Texas Open Meetings Act will conduct a Public Hearing and Special Meeting Thursday, <u>November 19, 2015 at 6:30 p.m.</u> at the Town Office at 104 South San Roman Road, Bayview, Texas

### **PUBLIC HEARING**

1. Call the Public Hearing to order.

2. Presiding Official's welcoming comments.

3. The Town of Bayview is conducting a Public Hearing to receive input from voters and residents on the following additions to Article X:

A. Adoption of the <u>2012</u> International Building Code, International Residential Code, International Plumbing Code and 2014 National Electric Code. This will change the wording of <u>Article X Sec 3 - A-4</u> from," *current edition of the National Electric Code, the International Plumbing Code and the International Residential Code*," to read, <u>2012 edition of the International Building Code</u>, *International Residential Code*, International Plumbing Code, and <u>2014</u> National Electric Code. The town must acquire at least one copy of each adopted code for the code year being utilized.

### B. Add Article X Section 3 A- 10

No permit, including, but not limited to, building permits or permits for excavation, shall be issued unless all taxes due and owing to the town of Bayview on the real estate and improvements whereon such house, building or structure is situated, or on which such demolition or moving is to take place, for the presiding fiscal year and before, are fully paid.

### C. Add <u>Article X Sec 3- A 11;</u>

All contractors doing work requiring a permit in the Town of Bayview must register with the Town and have a bond payable to the Town of Bayview. Property owners acting as their own contractor in building a new home will be required to register as a contractor and provide a bond payable to the Town.

D. Permit fees will be based on Valuations stated in the contract between owner and contractor or the accepted valuation as determined by the data published by the ICC sustaining current values of construction. The valuation shall include total value of work being done, including materials and labor, for which the permit is being issued, such as electrical, gas, mechanical, plumbing, equipment, and permanent systems, with the final valuation being determined by the Building inspector. If adopted, this phrase will replace the wording in <u>Article X Sec 3 - B Fee Schedule:</u> Fees will be based on the cost of construction (valuation) by the builder or the contractor.

This is an opportunity for citizens to address the Town Council on these specific matters that will be considered by the Town Council in this or a subsequent meeting. Town officials may make presentations and provide information to the public during the course of the hearing; however, the Mayor/Aldermen may not engage in debate with speakers or among themselves or act on any matters during the Public Hearing. Note: Speakers are required to state their names for the record and to limit their comments to three minutes.

8. Discussion and approval or rejection of a new <u>Article X Section 3- A- 11.</u>

<u>All</u> contractors doing work requiring a permit in the Town of Bayview must register with the Town and have a Bond payable to the Town of Bayview. Property owners, acting as their own contractor, in building a new home will be required to register as a contractor and provide a bond payable to the Town.

9. Discussion and approval or rejection of replacing the phrase in <u>Article X Sec 3 -B Fee Schedule</u> that states; *Fees will be based on the cost of construction (valuation) by the builder or the contractor.* 

<u>The new wording will be</u>; Permit fees will be based on <u>valuation</u> stated in the contract between the owner and the contractor <u>or</u> the accepted valuation as determined by the data published by the ICC, sustaining current values of construction. The <u>valuation</u> shall include total value of work being done, including materials and labor, for which the permit is being issued, such as electrical, gas, mechanical, plumbing, equipment, and permanent systems, with the final valuation being determined by the Building Inspector.
